Dear Eureka City Schools Parents/Guardians:

We are pleased to announce the open registration period for the 2022-2023 After School Programs at Eureka City Schools. The programs will begin on the first day of school, August 22.

Students in grades TK-8 are invited to apply. Our After School Programs are available to students at Alice Birney, Grant, Lafayette and Washington Elementary Schools, as well as at Zane and Winship Middle Schools. In order to receive first consideration for enrollment, please submit your application any time between May 2 and June 1, 2022. Applications received after June 1, will be placed on a waiting list.

The Eureka City Schools After School Programs are funded by a grant from the California Department of Education as part of the After School Education and Safety (ASES) program. This grant provides funding for students at each elementary school and the middle schools.

Although we have priority criteria for enrollment in the program (consideration given to foster and homeless youth, student academic need, family financial need, and parent work schedules) we are expecting to accommodate a greater number of students in 2022-2023 than in years past. We make an effort to keep siblings of the same household enrolled together. Currently enrolled students must reapply each year.

Please consider the following information in deciding if the ASES After School Program is the right fit for your child.

1. The ASES grant requires full time attendance in the after school program. Students are expected to attend the full program, each day. Allowances are made for occasional early release due to appointments, participation in sports, or transportation issues. Absences are excused for illness or appointments. Students with multiple absences or frequent early release will be dropped from the program and their space will be given to a student on the waiting list.
2. The After School Program provides a healthy meal through the Supper Program, homework support, physical education and a variety of enrichment activities each day. There are developmentally appropriate activities at each grade level. Please carefully consider whether your child's temperament is

suited for this multi-age, active, extended-day program.

If you are interested in applying for the After School Program, please fill out the attached application and return it to your school site. You can also mail your application to: Eureka City Schools, Attn: ASES program, 2100 "J" Street, Eureka, CA 95501.

You will receive notification of whether or not your child is enrolled in the program in late June. If you have any questions, please contact the ASES Program Coordinator at your child's school.

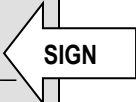

Early Release Policy

Students are expected to attend the program every day. A student may be released *early due to: a death/Emergency in the family, catastrophic incidents, medical Appointments, Weather conditions (especially if the child walks home), accidents or Injury/ illness that occur during program (staff will call parent or guardian), Transportation concerns, Sports events, Parallel Activities, and Other conditions (especially regarding safety) as prescribed by the school. Discuss any issues with the site coordinator. (You are also agreeing to pick up your child if he/she becomes sick or is injured during program.) RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY

Eureka City Schools contracts with a number of community organizations and agencies including the City of Eureka Recreation Division. The following Release and Waiver of Liability applies to Eureka City Schools and all contracting organizations/agencies.

In consideration for permitting my child to participate in after school- extended day activities, I hereby waive, release, and discharge any and all claims for damages for personal injury, death, or property damage which I may have or which may accrue as a result of my child's participation in said activities. I understand that the above activity may be of a hazardous nature and/or include physical and/or strenuous exercise or activity; that serious accidents occasionally occur during the above activity; and that participants in the above activity occasionally sustain mortal or personal injuries and/or property damages as a consequence thereof. Knowing the risks involved, nevertheless, I have voluntarily applied to let my child participate in said activity and I hereby agree to assume any and all risks of injury or death and to release and hold harmless Eureka City Schools and all other contracting organizations and agencies. I further understand and agree that this waiver, release and assumption of risk is to be binding on my heirs and assigns. I further agree to indemnify and to hold Eureka City Schools and all other contracting organizations and agencies (its officers, employees, volunteers and agents) free and harmless from any loss, liability, damage, cost or expense which they may incur as a result of any injury and/or property damage that my child may sustain while participating in said activity. Hours of Operation Every school day until 6:10 PM	The program is open every day from dismissal time until 6:10 p.m. (during regular days, parent conferences, and other minimum days). Attendance	Students are expected to attend the program at least 3 days each week. Students that do not attend at least 3 days a week may be asked to leave the program and the space given to another student. Priority will be given to students that attend 5 days a week.	
Absences Must be excused.	If your child will be absent, you <i>must</i> notify the Site Coordinator. Absences are excused only if we are notified ahead of time. Three unexcused absences or excessive absences of any kind may result in a student being asked to leave the program and the space given to another student.	
Early Release Policy	If you pick-up your child before 6:10 p.m., you must provide the site coordinator with a reason. Acceptable reasons are noted in the Early Release Policy* below. Frequent early pick-up may result in your child being dropped from the program. Talk to the site coordinator if you need special arrangements.	
Transportation Home	Please check one of the following: _____ My child will be picked up _____ My child will walk home On the application, you indicated who is authorized to pick up your child. If the person picking up your child is not on your list, we will not release your child without your permission.	
Pick Up Time by 6:00 p.m.	We are open until 6:10 p.m. Please pick up your child at Zane Middle School by 6:10 p.m. If we wait three times with your child after 6:10 p.m., it will result in removal from the program. If we wait more than 30 minutes, we will ask the Police Department to pick up the child.	
Who can pick up your child?	The application asks for names of people authorized to pick up your child. We will ask for their photo ID. If the person is not on the list, we will not release your child without your permission.	
Behavior	School rules are in effect during the program. Fighting, possession of a weapon or defiant behavior will result in the parent being called for immediate pickup. Suspensions or expulsions can occur based on after school behavior.	
Homework Is the student's responsibility.	Each site offers homework help and some tutoring. Homework help does not necessarily mean homework will be completed. It will depend on your child bringing homework with him/her and using the time well.	

***Early Release Policy** Students are expected to attend all afternoon, at least 3 days a week. A student may be released early for:

1. Family Emergencies (death in family, catastrophic incidents, etc.)
2. Medical appointments
3. Weather conditions
4. Accidents or illness during program
5. Transportation problems
6. Child's participation in a sports event
7. Other reasons where safety is a concern
8. Parallel Activities

Frequent early pickup may result in your child being asked to leave the program. Attendance is required under *Education Code 8483*. Talk to the site coordinator if you need special arrangements.
